



We started in the 60s concentrating on the Institute for Humane Studies. IHS was small then. 






A Maze of Money

One of the biggest political operations in 2012 took place outside the campaign finance system, involving a network of politically active nonprofits backed by the billionaire industrialists Charles and David Koch and other conservative donors. Seventeen allied groups in the coalition raised at least \$407 million, much of which was spent on get-out-the-vote efforts and ads attacking President Obama and congressional Democrats, according to tax filings and campaign finance reports. Many of the funds were transferred to LLC subsidiaries, known as disregarded entites, that are wholly owned by the recipient groups. The network also gave millions to other outside groups allied with the GOP.







TOP ALEC PRIORITY: ATTACKING UNIONS



FROM DOCUMENTED INVESTIGATIONS:

The American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC), a group that has spent decades working to undermine organized labor and worker protections, is to host a 5-hour meeting on December 3, 2019 with invited legislators and state think tanks to discuss the next steps of its anti-union project.



I would like to invite you to attend a half-day workplace freedom meeting on Tuesday, December 3rd before the ALEC States and Nation Policy Summit (SNPS) in Scottsdale, Arizona. The meeting will cover Janus decision implementation, union release time reform, union recertification and provide an opportunity to connect with staff from local think tanks.



'I want you to know that later this month, or any day now, the chances are good that we may actually have this unprecedented opportunity with the Janus Supreme Court case decision," Sharp told her donors. 'If it comes down on our side, of course, it makes every state a 'right-to-work' state. And so we have the opportunity to change the way the left funds everything that you and I disagree with." At a different point on the call, she said, 'Once this ruling comes down — and we do expect it to come down in our favor — everything will change. The door to pass a dream list of free-market reforms is going to swing open for us."




In recent years, the Bradley Foundation has spent money building up a conservative network in more than a dozen states.

The foundation is now targeting these five states based on the advice of consultants and staff. The grants in these states tend to be larger and riskier than its other ones.

States are graded from one to five in eight categories, with total scores ranging from 0 to 40. A higher score indicates a more established conservative network. Wisconsin rated the highest.

The internal records show the new dollars have already been spent in several states, including:

 Starting in 2016, the foundation put \$575,000 into five groups in Colorado, a key swing state. One group uses the money to recruit and train conservative activists and candidates while two others have the stated goal "to defund teachers unions." Quality of conservative infrastructure
